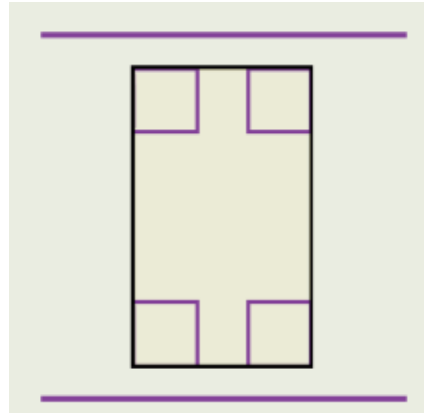

## Cardinal Room

Join us for our celebration of learning on Tuesday, May 14, from 2:00 - 2:45 p.m. as we answer our driving question: How do insects help the Borton community?

## Math

Students begin their study of geometry by describing and naming two-dimensional flat shapes by using defining attributes. At first, they count the number of sides on shapes to sort them into these categories: triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, and hexagons. They see that two shapes with the same number of sides that look different can still be given the same name. Students draw, name, and describe shapes (triangles, rectangles, squares, rhombuses, trapezoids, and hexagons) by using defining attributes such as square corners, parallel sides, and side lengths.
